Tasks for Facilitator

(Set the microphone on and let everyone know it is on and that they are ok with it.)

- 1) Introduce yourself by your name and that you are one of the people carrying out research for the project.
- 2) Get the group members to introduce themselves by stating:
 - Name
 - When they started playing cricket
 - Who they played cricket for
 - Whether they are still involved in cricket eg playing, coaching etc
- 3) Go through the questions and encourage discussion. Use the prompt questions if the discussion stops.
- 4) Allow the discussion to flow (approximately 5 minutes per question if it is a good discussion let it flow on, but try to move to next question after 10 minutes)
- 5) If you have gone through the questions, then give each person in group a few post it notes and ask them to write 'what they liked about cricket the most' and what they disliked the most about cricket' and 'if you could start your cricket career again, what one thing would you do differently' and stick on the flip chart paper.
- 6) Thank everyone for taking part and ask who has not done the questionnaire and tell them you need to complete the questionnaire with them.
- Collect the flip chart paper, voice recorder(switch off) and hand to S.Natha
- 8) Complete questionnaires with people identified. Hand completed forms to S.Natha
